

My Visit to Pleasant Sense Farm

Soon, I will be visiting a farm near Mount Pleasant.

This farm is called Pleasant Sense Farm.





When we arrive, a friendly dog called 'Wati' will bark at us because he is taught to bark at people he doesn't know.

The friendly dog will be behind a fence so he can't get out.

A farmer called 'Tanya' will welcome us and show us where to go to start the tour.

At the farm there are lots of different animals.

At the farm, I might be able to touch some of the animals.

It all depends on how the animals are feeling that day. Sometimes they love a pat but other times they might not. Some animals might prefer to stand back and watch us.

If I don't want to touch the animals, I can watch someone else do it. That will be ok too.

Farmer Tanya will bring some food for the animals. The donkey loves carrots!

Some of the animals might eat some food from our hands if the animal feels like it. Other animals may prefer to stand back and just watch us. That's ok.

If I just want to watch others hand feed the animals, that's fine too.



We should all stay together at the farm. I should not go off on my own.

Farmer Tanya will stay with us while we visit all the animals. She will make sure we stay safe.



We will see a big red motorbike with 4 wheels. The motorbike will not turn on or move.

We can take turns to sit on the motorbike if we want to.

I might want my photo taken so I can remember my exciting farm visit!

The Farm has lots of different sounds.

I might hear cows mooing, the dog barking, chickens clucking, goats bleating, the wind swirling through the trees, birds singing, people chatting or the bell ringing.

On our way back, Farmer Tanya will take us to the secret 'fairy forest' where we can see their fairy house.

If I am getting overwhelmed, I can tell someone I know. We can go somewhere quiet until I feel better.



When the tour is over, Farmer Tanya will invite us to have some food and a drink near the house.

If I don't want to have anything to eat or drink, that is ok too.

Before we leave, I can have some play time near the house if I want to, and explore the nature garden.
